## A Brief Introduction to the Author and his Book

Qady Iyad relates that the Messenger of God, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Recognition of the family of Muhammad is freedom from the Fire. Love of the family of Muhammad is crossing over the *Sirat*. Friendship for the family of Muhammad is safety from the Fire".

Jalaluddin Abdul Rahman Suyuti was born at Cairo and died there in 910 A.H. He travelled to various places in search of knowledge and visited Egypt, Syria, Hejaz, Yemen, India and Africa. His fields of specialization were, the exegesis of the Holy Ouran, Traditions, Jurisprudence and Arabic Grammar. At the age of forty years he withdrew from public life and spent all his time writing, compiling and translating books. At the time of his death he had completed nearly 600 books on a range of subjects, including poetry. He was one of the greatest scholars of his time in Cairo, and a well-known figure among his contemporaries. In his own home-town in the district of Isyut he was considered by the people to be a holy personality having miraculous powers. He was a follower of the Shadhali Tariga (Sufi Order) and a graduate of Al Azhar, the world's oldest university and Sunni Islam's foremost seat of learning. The following work of his is most definitely a most precious work and the study of it and its contents a must for all lovers of the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him and his family). We pray Allah Most High accepts it from him and makes it a means for spreading love for those whom Allah Himself has ordered His slaves to love for the sake of His Messenger and the Truth which he brought. Ameen.

# 'Ihyaail Mayyit be Fazail-e-Ahlul Bayt'

# In the Name of Allah the Beneficent the Merciful

Praise be to Allah and benediction upon those purified personalities who were the chosen ones from all of humanity- Muhammad and the House of Muhammad. This is a collection of sixty traditions and I have given it the title 'Ihyaail Mayyit be Fazail-e-Ahlul Bayt' (Excellences of the Ahlul Bayt through which the dead (hearts) are brought back to life).

By this endeavour the writer's aim is to awaken the people from their slumber like the revivification of a dry tree. So that, the excellences of the House of Muhammad inculcates in the people love for these noble personages and by following their example they may achieve success in this world as well as the hereafter.

#### Tradition 1

اخرج سعيد بن منصور في سننه عن سعيد بن جبير في قوله تعالى: {قُل لا أَسَالَكُم عليه اجرًا الآ المودّة في الفّربي} وقال قربي رسول الله صلى الله طيه و آله وسلم.

It is recorded in the Sunan of Saeed Ibn Mansoor from Saeed Ibn Jubair that, the people whose love has been made obligatory in the Quranic verse, "Say I do not ask for any recompense for this except the love of my nearest relatives"  $\underline{1}$ ; are the nearest of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him).  $\underline{2}$ 

# Tradition 2

اخرج ابن المنذر و ابن ابى حاتم و ابن مردويه فى تفاسير هم و الطبر انى فى تفاسير هم و الطبر انى فى المعجم الكبير عن ابن عباس: قال لمانزلت هذه الآيه {قُلُ لَا أَسَالُكُم عليه اجراً الآ المودّة في القربى } قالوا: يا رسول الله من قرابتك هؤلاء الذين وجبت علينا مودتهم؟ قال: على و فاطمه و ولداهما".

It has been recorded in the commentaries of Ibn Mundhir, Ibn Ibi Hatim and Ibn Murduwya; and also in the Mujmaul Kabir of Tibrani that Ibn Abbas said: "When the verse, 'Say I do not ask for any recompense for this except the love of my nearest relatives' was revealed, I asked, "O Messenger of Allah who are your nearest relatives whose love is obligatory for us"? The Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) replied, "Ali, Faitma, and their two sons." 1

#### Tradition 3

Ibn Abi Hatim narrates from Ibn Abbas regarding the verse of Quran: "...and whoever earns good," Ibn Abbas said that it refers to those who love the House of Muhammad." 3

And it is narrated from Imam Hasan (peace be upon him) that he said, "Earning of good is loving us Ahlul Bayt." 1

It is the honour achieved only through the love and attachment of the Ahlul Bayt.

# Tradition 4

Ahmed, Tirmidhi, Sehah, Nasai and Hakim have all narrated through Matlab bin Rabi that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "By Allah! Faith cannot enter the heart of anyone if he does not love my nearest relatives for the sake of Allah and for the sake of the nearest relatives." 2

#### **Tradition 5**

Muslim, Tirmidhi and Nasai have recorded from Zaid bin Arqam that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "Fear Allah! Beware that you do not distance yourself from my Ahlul Bayt."

The same tradition is recorded in Sahih Muslim in the chapter of the excellences of Ali Ibn Abi Talib (peace be upon him). The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) has repeated the words "Fear Allah" thrice.1

اخرج الترمذي و حسنه و الحاكم عن زيد بن ارقم قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم: ''إتّى تاركّ فيكم ما أن تمسكتُم به لن تضلّو ا بعدي، كتاب الله و عترتي اهل بيتي ولن يتفرقا حتّى يردا علىّ الحوض فانظروا كيف تخلفوني فيهما.''

Tirmidhi, Husna and Al-Hakim record from Zaid bin Arqam that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "I am leaving amongst you those things that if you remain attached to them you will not deviate after me. (they are) The book of Allah and my Progeny, my Ahlul Bayt. They will not separate till they reach me at the pool. So be careful how you behave with them (after me).2

# **Tradition 7**

اخرج عبد بن حمید فی مسنده عن زید بن ثابت قال: قال رسول الله صلی الله طیه و آله وسلم: ''اِتّی تاركٌ فیكم ما انْ تُمسّكُتُم به بَعدی لم تضلوا كتابَ الله وعترتی اهلَ بیتی و اِتّهما لن یتفرقا حتی یردا علیّ الحوض.''

Abd bin Hameed has mentioned in his Musnad that Zaid Ibn Thabit reported from the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him): "I leave amongst you those things that if you remain attached with them you will not deviate after me. (They are) the Book of Allah and my Progeny, my Ahlul Bayt. They will not separate till they meet me at the Hauz (of Kausar).

Ahmad and Abu Yaala relate from Abu Saeed Khudri that the Prophet of Allah remarked: "In the near future I would be summoned by Allah and I would respond. I leave amongst you two weighty things, The Book of Allah and my Progeny, my Ahlul Bayt. The All-Aware and the Kind Allah has informed me that these two will not separate till they reach me at the Hauz (Cistern of Kausar). So take care as to how you behave with them. 1

# **Tradition 9**

Tirmidhi, Husnah and Tibrani quote Ibn Abbas that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "Love Allah for His countless bounties upon you and love me because you love Allah, and my Ahlul Bayt because of me.

The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) also said: "The love of Ahlul Bayt (peace be upon him) for a single day is better than a worship of whole year."2

#### **Tradition 10**

Bukhari has narrated from Abu Bakr that he said: "Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him) should be considered to belong to his Ahlul Bayt (peace be upon him)."3

اخرج الطبرانى والحاكم عن ابن عباس قال: قال رسول الله صلى
الله عليه وآله وسلم: ''يا بنى عبد المطلب اتّى سلّت الله لكم ثالثاً
سألته ان يثبت و ان يعلم جاهلكم ويهدى ضالكم وسألته أن يجعلكم
جوداء نجداء رحماء فلو انّ رجلاً صفن بين الركن والمقام فصلّى
وصام ثمّ مات و هم يبغض لأهل بيت محمّد (صلى الله عليه وآله
وسلم) دخل لنار .''

Tibrani and Hakim have reported through Ibn Abbas that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "O sons of Abdul Muttalib; I pray to Allah that He maintains and establishes three things among you; that is your ignorant may acquire knowledge, your misguided ones receive guidance and may you be bestowed, generosity, helpfulness and mercy.

One who prays and fasts all his life and dies between Rukn and Maqam, but harbours malice against the Ahlul Bayt of Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him) will be made to enter (Hell) Fire."4

#### **Tradition 12**

اخرج الطبرانى عن ابن عباس ان رسول الله صلى الله عليه وآله وسلم قال: ''بغض بنى هاشم و الاتصار كفرو فى بغض العرب نفاق.''

Tibrani has also quoted the Messenger of Allah through Ibn Abbas: "Hatred of Bani Hashim and the Ansar (supporters) is (equivalent to) disbelief and hatred of the Arabs is hypocrisy".5

Ibn Adi mentions in his book from Abu Saeed Khudri that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "One who hates us, the Ahlul Bayt, is a hypocrite."1

#### **Tradition 14**

Ibn Hayyan records in his Sahih and Hakim has also quoted Abu Saeed that the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "By the one who controls my life! Whoever hates us, the Ahlul Bayt, will made to enter the fire (of Hell) by Allah."2

#### **Tradition 15**

Tibrani mentions that Al-Hasan Ibn Ali (peace be upon him) told Moawiya Ibn Khudij: "I warn you against hating us, for surely the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) has said: "None hates us and none envies us except that he will be chased away from the Hauz (Pool) by maces of fire." 3

# **Tradition 16**

Ibn Adi mentions and Baihaqi in his book Shuayb Al-Imaan relates from the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) thus: "One who is not cognizant of my progeny and the Ansar belongs to one of the three groups: Either he is a hypocrite, or an illegitimate born or he was conceived when his mother was menstruating."4

#### **Tradition 17**

Tibrani writes in his book Al-Awsat that Ibn Umar remarked: "The last words of the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) were, "You have ignored my successors who are from my Ahlul Bayt." (that is, I can see how you behave with the trusts that I leave behind among you)."5

#### **Tradition 18**

اخرج الطبراني في الاوسط عن الحسن بن على ان رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم قال: ''الزموا مودّتنا اهل البيت فإنّه من لقى الله تعالى و هو يودّنا دخل الجنة بشفاعتنا والذي نفسى بيده لا ينفع عبدًا عمل عمله الآبمعرفة حقنا.''

Tibrani also mentions the following tradition in his book Al-Awsat. Imam Hasan Ibn Ali (peace be upon him) reports from the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) that he said: "Strive hard to achieve love and affection of us; the Ahlul Bayt, and considers it as obligatory for yourselves, always. The truth is that whoever meets Allah while he loves us will enter Paradise through my intercession. By the One who controls my life! No deed can benefit a servant if he does not recognize our rights." 6

# **Tradition 19**

اخرج الطبر انى فى الاوسط عن جابر بن عبد الله قال خطبنا رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم فسمعته و هو يقول: ''ايها لناس مَنْ أبغضنَا اهل البيت حشره الله تعالى يوم القيامة يهوديًا.''

Tibrani in book Al-Awsat quotes from Jabir Ibn Abdullah that the Holy

Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) addressed thus: "O People! One who hates us; the Ahlul Bayt, will be gathered along with the Jews by Allah on the Day of Qiyamat." 1

#### **Tradition 20**

اخرج الطبراني في الاوسط عن عبد الله بن جعفر سمعت رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم يقول: ''يا بنى هاشم انى قد سألت الله لكم أن يجعلكم نجداء رحماء و سلّته ان يهدى ضالكم و يؤمن أحدكم حتى يحبكم بحبّى اترجون ان تدخلوا الجنة بشفاعتى و لا يرجو ها بنو عبد المطلب؟''

In the book Al-Awsat, Tibrani narrates from Abdullah Ibn Jafar that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) says: "O the sons of Hashim! I pray to Allah that you may always be generous and merciful. And I pray to Him that He may guide the misguided ones from you, and bestow tranquility upon the fearful ones, and satiate the hungry ones. By the one who controls my life none can achieve tranquility except that he loves you and loves you for the sake of me. And wishes that I will intercede for him to be allowed to enter Paradise. But all of the sons of Abdul Muttalib are not like this."2

#### Tradition 21

اخرج ابن ابى شيبه ومسدد في مسنديهما والحكيم الترمذى في نو ادر الاصول وابو يعلى والطبرانى عن سلمة بن الاكوع قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وآله وسلم: ''النجوم أمان لأهل السماء و اهل بيتى أمان لأمّتى.''

Ibn Ali Sheba and Musdad in their respective Musnads, and Al-Hakim Al-Tirmidhi in the book Nawadirul Usool and Abu Yaala and Tibrani relate from Salmah bin Alkao that the Messenger of Allah said: "The stars are the safety for the inhabitants of the sky and my Ahlul Bayt are the safety for my Ummah."3

#### **Tradition 22**

اخرج لبزاز عن ابی هریره قال: قال رسول الله صلی الله علیه و آله وسلم: ''إنی قد خلفت فیکم ائتین لن تضلوا بعدهما کتاب الله و نسبتی ولن یتفرقا حتی یردا علیّ الحوض.''

Al-Bazzaz narrates from Abu Huraira that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) remarked: "Surely I leave behind me amongst you two things, you will not deviate if you follow them. (They are) the Book of Allah and my relatives. And they will not separate till they reach me at the pool (Hauz Kauthar)."4

Al-Bazzaz quotes Ali (peace be upon him) that the Prophet of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "Certainly I am to die shortly! And I leave among you two weighty things. The Book of Allah and my Ahlul Bayt. If you follow them you will not go astray."5

# **Tradition 24**

Al-Bazzaz narrates through Abdullah Ibn Zubair that the Holy Prophet mentioned: "The simile of Ahlul Bayt is like that of the Ark of Noah (peace be upon him). One who boards it, is saved and those who leave it are drowned."6

# **Tradition 25**

Ibn Abbas has also mentioned, according to Al-Bazzaz, the following prophetic tradition: "My Ahlul Bayt are like the Ark of Noah (peace be upon him), whoever boards it is saved whoever remains aloof is drowned." 1

أخرج الطبرانى عن ابى ذرقال: سمعت رسول الله صلى الله عليه وآله وسلم يقول: ''مثل اهل بيتى فيكم كَمثل سفينة نوح فى قوم نوح من ركبها نجى و من تخلف عنها و مثل باب حطة في بنى اسرائيل.''

According to Tibrani, Abu Zar (may Allah be pleased with him) has quoted the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) thus: "My Ahlul Bayt among you is like the Ark of Noah (peace be upon him) among the people of Noah. Those who board it are saved and those who keep aloof from it are destroyed." And my Ahlul Bayt are like the door of repentence of the Bani Israel (whosoever entered it was saved)."2

#### **Tradition 27**

اخرج الطبر انى فى الاوسط عن ابى سعيد الخدرى قال: سمعت رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم يقول: ''اتّها مثل اهل بيتى كمثل سفينة نوح من ركبها نجى ومن تخلّف عنها غرق و اتّها مثل اهل بيتى فيكم مثل باب حطة فى بنى اسر ائيل من دخله غفر له.''

Tibrani records in his book Al-Awsat that Abi Saeed Khudri heard the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) say: "Verily the simile of my Ahlul Bayt is like the boat of Noah (peace be upon him). One who boards it is saved and one who leaves it is drowned. And verily the simile of my Ahlul Bayt among you is like that of the door of repentance which was among the Bani Israel. Whoever entered it was forgiven."3

# **Tradition 28**

اخرج ابن النجار في تاريخه عن الحسن بن على قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم يقول: ''لكلّ شيء اساس و اساس الاسلام حبّ اصحاب رسول الله وحبّ اهل بيته.''

Ibn Anjaar in his history narrates from Imam Hasan Ibn Ali (peace be upon him) that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) stated, "For everything there is a foundation and the foundation of Islam is the love of the Companions of the Messenger of Allah and the love of his Ahlul Bayt."4

# **Tradition 29**

اخرج الطبرانى عن عمر قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم: ''قل بنى انتى فإنَّ عصبتهم لابيهم ما خلا ولد فاطمه فإنّى عصبتهم فأنا أبو هم.''

Umar is quoted by Tibrani that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be

upon him) said: "The sons of every mother are recognised by the relation with their respective fathers except the sons of Fatima (peace be upon her). For surely they shall be related to me. I am their father."

#### **Tradition 30**

Tibrani narrates from Fatima az-Zahra (peace be upon her) that she quoted, the Holy Prophet of Islam to have said: "The sons of every mother are referred to by their relation to their father except the sons of Fatima (peace be upon her). I am their guardian and they are related to me) as sons)."

#### **Tradition 31**

Al-Hakim has also mentioned a similar tradition through Jabir. Jabir quotes the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) to have said: "For the sons of all the mothers, their agnation returns to their fathers, except the sons of Fatima, as I am their guardian and agnation".1

# **Tradition 32**

Tibrani quotes Jabir to have heard Umar Ibn Khattab saying on the occassion of the marriage of the daughter of Ali (peace be upon him): "Will you not allow me to wish and congratulate? Because I have heard the

Messenger of Allah say, "Every relationship and ancestry shall be severed on the day of Qiyamat except my relationship and ancestry.""2

#### **Tradition 33**

Ibn Abbas has been quoted by Tibrani, whereby he relates from the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) the saying, "On the day of Qiyamat every relationship and kinship will come to an end except my relationship and kinship."3

#### **Tradition 34**

Ibn Asakir in his history has recorded from Ibn Umar that he quoted the Prophet thus: "Every kinship and relationship (by marriage) shall be severed on the day of judgement except my kinship and relationship (by marriage)."4

# **Tradition 35**

Al-Hakim has recorded a tradition of the Holy Prophet through Ibn Abbas. The Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) remarked: "The stars are security for the people of the earth against drowning (when at sea) and Ahlul Bayt are a security to the people of the earth against discord. And if any tribe or group opposes my Ahlul Bayt it will itself become fraught with discord and become a party to Iblis."5

# **Tradition 36**

Al-Hakim narrates through Anas that the Messenger of Allah mentioned: "My Lord has promised me that from my Ahlul Bayt; whosoever confesses

to His Oneness, then without any delay it is announced that Allah will not send punishment upon them."6

# **Tradition 37**

Ibn Jabir Tabari in his exegesis of the Holy Quran narrates a tradition of Ibn Abbas concerning the Quranic verse, "And soon will your Lord give you so that you shall be well pleased." (Surah Duha 93:5). He says: "The Messenger of Islam will be pleased when not a single member of his family would have to enter Hell." 1

#### **Tradition 38**

Al-Bazzaz, Abu Yaala, Oqili, Tibrani and Ibn Shahin in his Sunnah has narrated from Ibn Masud that the Holy Prophet said: "Certainly my daughter is chaste, righteous and discriminating between the prohibited and permitted of Allah. Moreover, Allah has prohibited the fire of Hell for her progeny (her sons)." 2

# **Tradition 39**

Tibrani mentions that Ibn Abbas quoted the following prophetic tradition addressed to Fatima (peace be upon her): "Truly you and your sons will be

immune from Divine chastisement."3

#### **Tradition 40**

Tirmidhi and Husna record from Jabir that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "O People! I leave among you those things which if you hold fast you will never go astray. They are the book of Allah and my progeny, my Ahlul Bayt."4

# **Tradition 41**

Khatib Baghdadi in this Tarikh (history) records a tradition of Ali (peace be upon him) wherein he refers to the words of Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him): "My intercession for my Ummat (people) is for those who love my Ahlul Bayt."5

#### **Tradition 42**

Tibrani quotes Ibn Umar that the Prophet of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "The first people for whom I shall intercede from my Ummat are my Ahlul Bayt."6

اخرج الطبر انى عن المطلب بن عبد الله ابن حَنْطَب عن أبيه قال: خطبنا رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم بالجحفه فقال: ''الست أولى بكم من انفسكم قالو ا: بلى يا رسول الله. قال: فإنّى سائلكم عن الثين عن القر آن و عن عترتى.''

Tibrani writes from Al-Matlab bin Abdullah Ibn Hantab from his father. He says that I heard the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) announce at Johfa: "Am I not more superior to you than yourselves?" The people replied: Yes, O Messenger of Allah! The Prophet then said: "I will question you (hold you responsible) about two things; the Quran and my Ahlul Bayt."1

# **Tradition 44**

اخرج الطبر انى عن ابن عباس قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم: "الاتزول قدما عبد حتى يسل عن اربع، عن عمره فيما أفناه وعن جسده فيما ابلاه وعن ماله فيما انفقه ومن اين اكتسبه و عن حبّنا اهل بيت."

Tibrani records through Ibn Abbas that the Prophet of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "(on the Resurrection day) no foot a servant (of Allah) will move before being asked about four things:

- (1) his years and how he spent them
- (2) his body and how he worn it out
- (3) his wealth and how he spent it and
- (4) about his love towards us, (the Ahlul Bayt)"2

#### **Tradition 45**

Daylami quotes Ali (peace be upon him) to have heard from the Messenger of Allah, "The first ones to arrive at the pool (of Kausar in Paradise) will be my Ahlul Bayt."3

اخرج الديلمى عن على قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم: ''أنّبوا او لادكم على ثلاث خصال: حبّ نبيّكم وحبّ اهل بيته و على قراءة القرآن فإنّ حملة القرأن في ظلّ الله يوم لا صلّ الآ ظلّه مع انبيائه و اصفيائه.''

Daylami has also mentioned the following tradition of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) through Ali (peace be upon him): "Teach your children three habits; to love your Prophet, to love his (Prophet's) household and to recite the Quran; because the carrier of the Quran will be in the shade of Allah along with His Prophet and the chosen ones on the day when there will be no shade except that of Allah's."4

## **Tradition 47**

Ali (peace be upon him) has also been recorded by Daylami to have quoted from the Messenger of Islam (peace and blessings be upon him) the following tradition: "The most sure-footed upon the bridge of Seraat will be those who were more deeply in love of my Ahlul Bayt and my Companions." 5

#### **Tradition 48**

Daylami also mentions that Ali (peace be upon him) quoted the Messenger of Allah as saying: "I will intercede for four kinds of people:

- (1) Those who loved and respected my progeny.
- (2) Those who fulfilled their needs and solved their problems.
- (3) Those who helped them in difficulties and in times of needs.
- (4) Those who maintained their respect and friendship by words and by heart."6

Daylami quotes Abu Saeed Khudri that the Prophet of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "The Almighty Allah shall be extremely infuriated at the one who hurts my progeny."1

## **Tradition 50**

Daylami has quoted Abu Hurayra that Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) remarked: "The Almighty Allah will be infuriated with six types of people:

- (1) Those who eat in spite of a full stomach.
- (2) Those who disobey Allah's commands.
- (3) Those who disregard the practice of the Messenger of Allah.
- (4) One who disregards his responsibility after accepting it under oath.
- (5) Those who continue to harbour enmity against the Progeny of the Messenger (peace and blessings be upon him).
- (6) And those who refrain from fulfilling the rights of his neighbours."2

# **Tradition 51**

Daylami narrates from Abu Saeed that the Holy Prophet (peace and

blessings be upon him) said: "My Ahlul Bayt and my helpers (Ansars) are my legatees and successors. So have regard for them and help them. Gather around them and attach yourselves to them. And keep aloof from those who disregard them."3

# **Tradition 52**

Abu Nuaym relates from Uthman bin Affan that he quoted the Messenger of Allah thus: "One who is kind towards the sons of Abdul Muttalib and is not recompensed for it in this world shall be compensated by me on the day of Qiyamat."4

# **Tradition 53**

Khateeb records from Uthman bin Affan that the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "It is obligatory for me to reward on the day of judgement one who does a single good to one of the children of Abdul Muttalib or to one of his progeny." 5

# **Tradition 54**

Ibn Asakir narrates from Ali (peace be upon him) that he quoted the Prophet of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him): "I will recompense on the day of Qiyamat one who fulfills the rights of even one of my Ahlul Bayt."6

#### **Tradition 55**

اخرج الباور دى عن ابى سعيد قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله طيه و آله وسلم: ''اتى تارك فيكم ما ان تمسكتم به لن تضلوا كتاب الله سبب طرفه بيد الله و طرفه بأيديكم و عترتى أهل بيتى واتهما لن يفتر قا حتى يردا على الحوض.''

Al-Bawardi relates from Abu Saeed that he mentions from the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him): "I leave among you those things and as long as you hold fast to them you will not go astray. (They are) the book of Allah (Quran) whose one end is with Allah and other with you. And my progeny, my Ahlul Bayt. And these two will not separate till they reach me at the Hauz (Pool of Kausar in Paradise)." 1

#### **Tradition 56**

اخرج احمد و الطبر انى عن زيد بن تابت قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم: ''انى تارك فيكم خليفتين كتاب الله حبل ممدود ما بين السماء و الارض و عترتى اهل بيتى و اتهما لن يفتر قا حتّى يردا على الحوض.''

Ahmad and Tibrani relate from Zaid Ibn Thabit that the Messenger of Allah said: "I am leaving among you the two Khalifatain (two successors); that is the book of Allah and my progeny. The book of Allah is a rope stretching between the heaven and the earth, and my progeny are the Ahlul Bayt. They would not part (with each other) until they come to me at the pool (in Paradise)."2

## **Tradition 57**

اخرج الترمذى و الحاكم و البيهقى فى شعب الايمان عن عايشه مر فوعًا بستة لعنتهم (و) لعنهم الله و كل نبى مجاب، الزائد في كتاب الله و المكذب بقدر الله والمتسلط بالجبر وت فيعزّ بذلك من أذلّ الله و يذلّ من أعزّ الله و المستحلّ لحرم الله و المستحلّ من عترتى ما حرّم الله و التّارك لسنّتى.

Tirmidhi and Al-Hakim record and Baihaqi in his book Shaeb Al-Imaan also quotes Ayesha that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "I have cursed six types of people and Allah has cursed them too. And also the Prophets whose prayers are accepted:

(1) Those who make changes in the divine books.

- (2) Those who deny the Might of Allah.
- (3) Those who rule unjustly upon my Ummat (people) and respects those whom Allah has degraded and degrades those whom Allah has exalted.
- (4) Those who permit the prohibited acts.
- (5) Those who consider permissible for my progeny whatever Allah had prohibited regarding them.
- (6) Those who leave my Sunnah (practice)."3

اخرج الدار قطنى فى الافر اد والخطيب فى المتفق عن على : قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم: ' ستة لعنهم الله و لعنتهم و كل نبى مجاب الزائد فى كتاب الله و المكذب بقدر الله و الرّاغب عن سنّتى الى بدعة و المستحلّ من عترتى ما حرّم الله و المتسلّط على امّتى بالجبروت ليعزّ من أذلّ الله ويذلّ من اعزّ الله و المرتد اعر ابيًا بعد هجريّه.''

Darqutni records in his Al-Afraad and Khatib in his book Al-Muttafiq from Ali (peace be upon him) that the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "The curse of Allah and the curse of the Prophets whose prayers are accepted, will be upon six types of people:

- (1) Those who make additions to the book of Allah.
- (2) Those who deny the Might and Decree of Allah.
- (3) Those who leave my Sunnah (practice) and indulge in innovations (bidaa).
- (4) Those who consider permissible for my Ahlul Bayt whatever Allah has made prohibited with regard to them.
- (5) Those who unjustly acquire rule upon my people and exalt those whom Allah had degraded and degrade those whom Allah has exalted.
- (6) Those who revert to disbelief after accepting Islam."4

# **Tradition 59**

اخرج الحاكم في تاريخة و الديلمى عن ابى سعيد فى الحلية عن عثمان بن عفان قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه و آله وسلم: ''ثلاث من حفظهن حفظ الله له دينه و دنياه و من ضيّعهنّ لم يحفظ الله له شيئاً، حرمة الاسلام و حرمتى و حرمة رحمى.'' Al-Hakim in his history and Daylami has also related from Abu Saeed that the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) said: "Allah will protect the life and the faith of those who regard three things and Allah will not help those who disregard three things (that is he will be in loss in this life as well as the hereafter):

- (1) Respect for Islam.
- (2) Respect for Prophet of Islam (peace and blessings be upon him).
- (3) And respect for the household of Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) i.e. Ahlul bayt."5

# **Tradition 60**

Daylami narrates through Ali (peace be upon him) that he quoted the Messenger of Allah: "The best of the people are Arabs, the best of the Arabs are Quraysh and the best of the Quraysh are Bani Hashim (the sons of Hashim)." 6

The High and the Almighty Allah is all Knowing. The book Ihyail Mayyit be Fazaile Ahlul Bayt is concluded. It is a book which mentions the excellences of Ahlul Bayt. It is compiled by the great scholar Imam Jalaluddin Abdul Rahman Al Suyuti.

May Allah reward him with Paradise for his efforts.
